SALGA to convene National Members Assembly to reflect on local government progress since the municipal elections and the adoption of the White Paper

The South African Local Government Association (SALGA) will hold its National Members Assembly (NMA) from 10 -12 December 2018 under the theme “20 Years since the adoption of the White Paper on Local Government: Reflections on Building a Sustainable, Responsive & People Centred Local Government System”.

The NMA will be attended by over 1200 delegates comprised of political leaders from National, Provincial and Local government, municipal managers and chief financial officers from municipalities across the country, as well as dignitaries and international guests.

The NMA is an annual general meeting of SALGA members made up of all 257 municipalities in the country. The Constitution of SALGA calls for Members of SALGA to meet at least twice in between National Conference. The NMA will consider reports in order to reflect on the progress made and challenges faced by local government since the municipal elections in August 2016. Critical to the sector, is for all role players to examine the current challenges facing the sector and to bring about solutions as envisaged in line with the White Paper in Local Government.
